

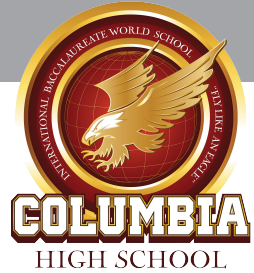

Columbia High School is located in Cummings Research Park and is authorized as an International Baccalaureate World School. We are the only high school designated as such in North Alabama. We offer three International Baccalaureate (IB) Programmes: The Middle Years Programme (MYP) for students in grades 9-10; the Diploma Programme (DP) or the Career-related (CP) for students in grades 11-12. The aim of all IB Programmes is to develop internationally-minded people who recognize their common humanity and shared guardianship of the planet. To accomplish this, IB Programmes provide students with opportunities for sustained inquiry into a wide range of local and global issues and ideas. Students reflect on their own perspective, culture, identities, and then on those of others by learning to appreciate different beliefs, values, experiences, and to think and collaborate across cultures and disciplines.
