

THE 2015 PSAT/NMSQT

Q. What is the PSAT/NMSQT?

A. The **Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test (PSAT/NMSQT)** is a [standardized test](#) administered by the [College Board](#) and cosponsored by the [National Merit Scholarship Corporation \(NMSC\)](#) in the [United States](#). Approximately 3.5 million students take the PSAT/NMSQT each year. In 2013, 1.59 million high school sophomores and 1.55 million high school juniors took the PSAT. The scores from the PSAT/NMSQT are used to determine eligibility and qualification for the [National Merit Scholarship Program](#).

Q. When is the test?

A. Wednesday October 14th. (8:00 a.m. until ~ 12:00 p.m.)

Q. Where do I take the test?

A. On Huntsville High School Campus.

Q. Who can take the test?

A. All 11th and 10th grade students are eligible to take the test.

Q. How much does the test cost?

A. Each 11th grade student must pay \$16.00.

Q. How do I pay for the test?

A. See Counselor Watson, (the 11th grade Counselor) to pay for the test. Plan to pay by Thursday October 1st, 2015. Make checks payable to Huntsville High School.
