### **News from the Dance Studio (but applicable across all settings)**

It is important to us to provide every student with a safe learning environment. We must be aware of students with life-threatening allergies including (but not limited to) food allergies, allergic asthma and contact dermatitis. If these children are accidentally exposed to an allergen they could have: hives, swelling of the face/lips and difficulty breathing. We want to minimize the risk of exposure that could lead to a life threatening reaction.

Please discuss the following procedures with your child that must be followed by every student entering the dance studio.

1. Students may bring a bottle of water to class. No other food or drink is allowed in the dance studio or locker rooms.
2. Backpacks, bags, purses, etc. are not allowed in the dance studio/locker rooms and should be hung on the hooks in the cafeteria.
3. Only required dance attire may be taken into the locker rooms (Girl-leotard, leggings, tights, dance shoes. Boys - t-shirt, shorts/pants, dance shoes). Students may also have a NON-AEROSAL stick of deodorant. No other items may be stored in the locker rooms.
