Non-Traditional Athletes: ACADEMIC ACCOUNTABILITY

Students will adhere to all AHSAA rules applicable to academic accountability – Section 9: Academic Rule Requirements

Non-Traditional Athletes will be required to take AHSAA Eligibility tests developed through a partnership between the AHSAA, the ALSDE, and SCANTRON in all four core subjects at the end of each semester for academic eligibility beginning with grade 7 through the end of the first semester in grade 12.

All assessment testing will be conducted on the campus of the school under the supervision of a certified instructor employed by the school.

These four core assessments can be any four core courses the home school student is taking through their home school program.

The grade received on the tests will determine their grade in iNOW in that course

These six grades will be used to determine their eligibility for next year

Scores

The Non-Traditional Athletes must pass the four core assessments and have a numerical average of 70 in the six units in all (same as the traditional student)

Non-Traditional Athletes that participate in interscholastic athletics with AHSAA member public schools must strictly follow AHSAA Bylaws regarding Home School Guidelines
