The location for a student's receipt of Gastrostomy Tube (G-Tube) or Jejunostomy (J Tube) feedings will be determined collaboratively by the student's Section 504 or IEP team. An initial presumption exists that the location of such feedings is to occur in a non-segregated setting unless the Section 504 or IEP team collaboratively determines that a significant medical or safety reason prohibits the use of a non-segregated setting classroom as a viable location for the feedings. A student's Section 504 or IEP team will adhere to all relevant Section 504 and/or IDEA regulations to ensure that students with disabilities receive services in the regular educational environment to the maximum extent appropriate based on the need of the student with the disability. A Section 504 or IEP team when evaluating data and making placement decisions for students with disabilities will further ensure that information obtained from all sources is documented and carefully considered by the team and that the placement decision is made by a group of persons knowledgeable about the student, the meaning of the evaluation date, and the placement options.
